It's a request for an informal Listening Session, anchored with the comments of Chapter 13 Trustees Rod Danielson and Amrane Cohen, to allow Judge Clarkson, Chair of the Central District of California Case Management Committee and Riverside representative of the Board of Judges' Executive Committee, to listen to community members and canvass arising issues regarding current Chapter 13 procedures after the implementation of the new Chapter 13 form plan.

How is the new Plan form working? How are calendar systems working? What could be improved with the form(s) and system? How broad are the judicial variances in Riverside and Santa Ana Divisions?
